

As we near the annual celebration of Valentine's Day the ecumenical lectionary offers us a complex Gospel reading (Matthew 5: 21-37) that raises a number of issues. The Law understood in purely legal terms can, suggests Jesus, end up being a moral or self-justifying check list. Jesus wants more from and *for* us. He wants us to see each other as God sees us by calling us to look beyond the law to its goal and end: the life and health of our neighbour. In this way, Jesus calls us to envision life in God's kingdom as constituted not so much by obedience to law but rather by holding the welfare of our neighbours close to our hearts while trusting that they are doing the same for us. In the mean world we currently inhabit embodying the realm of God that Jesus inaugurated in our homes and communities is a pretty radical act!
